

# SAR First Aid

This course is designed to provide the essential first aid skills required in the workplace and adds specific content relevant to first aid needs in the outdoors and in search and rescue and emergency response situations. A first aid competency card is issued valid for two years at the successful completion of this course.



Duration:

The core course material is normally delivered over **two days** and there is also pre-course work (available on line). Assessment occurs alongside the training.

Eligible for NZLSAR subsidy

Course recommended for: all search and rescue personnel.

Prerequisites: There are no prerequisites for this course although involvement in the search and rescue sector is preferred.

Venue recommendations: Classroom type facilities with extra breakout rooms and/or outdoor environment available for scenarios.

Venue hire, participant accommodation and catering are a local cost.

Equipment requirements: Personal SAR pack you would take out on a 24hr SAR callout (minus food)

Course Numbers minimum 16 and maximum 18

*Please Note: This course includes five modules, all of which are unit standards and require a \$25.00 registration "Hook on" fee to be paid if the student is not already registered with an active NZQA number. This is a TEC requirement.*
