

# Specialist Search Management

Normally grouped with other specialist training, such as elements of the leadership or lost subject categories programmes above, these modules cover the skills necessary to develop and apply targeted strategies to the effective management of searches in different operational contexts and scenarios.

Duration:

Modules may be delivered separately but are normally grouped with components from other courses to suit participant's needs and so the duration will therefore vary. Assessment occurs alongside the training; although on-going practice is expected.

Recommended for: all search and rescue personnel.

Venue recommendations: Classroom type facilities

Prerequisites: Successful completion of the Management of Land Search Operations course

Course Numbers: Desired minimum 12 and desired maximum 20
